

		BCS 5 VERY FAT	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bulging rump.• Deep gutter along back.• Ribs buried (cannot be felt).• Marked crest.• Folds and pads of fat.
		BCS 4 FAT	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rump well rounded.• Gutter along back.• Ribs and pelvis hard to feel.• Slight crest.
		BCS 3 GOOD	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rounded rump.• Spinal processes covered but can be felt.• Ribs covered but can easily be felt.• No crest, firm neck.
		BCS 2 MODERATE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Flat rump either side of backbone.• Ribs just visible.• Narrow but firm neck.• Spinal processes covered.
		BCS 1 POOR	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sunken rump.• Cavity under tail.• Ribs easily visible.• Prominent backbone and croup.• Ewe neck.
		BCS 0 VERY POOR	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Very sunken rump.• Deep cavity under tail.• Skin tight over ribs.• Very prominent backbone and croup.• Marked ewe neck.
